<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Christians believe that God created the world and humans.</li> <li>Christians believe we should look after the world because it belongs to God.</li> <li>Creation is the beginning of the 'big story' of the Bible.</li> </ul>	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Christians believe that God the Creator cares for his creation, including human beings</li> <li>Christians believe that as human beings are part of God's good creation, they do best when they listen to God.</li> <li>The Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him – he keeps his relationship with them &amp; gives them guidelines on good ways to live (eg the Ten Commandments).</li> <li>Christians believe God made our wonderful world and so we should look after it.</li> <li>The Bible tells a story, (in Genesis 3) about how humans spoiled their friendship with God (called 'The Fall')</li> <li>The Fall means that humans can't get close to God without God's help – repaired through Jesus' sacrifice</li> <li>Christians believe it is important to say sorry when they do something wrong and ask God for forgiveness through prayers.</li> </ul>	Christian	A person who believes in and follows the teachings of Jesus Christ.

		Bible	The Christian holy book, which is made up of two main parts: the Old Testament (the law, prophecy and writing of the Jewish people) and the New Testament (the Gospels, letters and stories about Jesus).
		Genesis	Greek word meaning 'beginning'. Genesis is the first book in the Christian Bible.
		The Fall	The separation between God and humans, caused when Adam and Eve disobeyed God and ate the forbidden fruit. When they fell from their state of innocence they brought sin into the world.
		Creator	Christians believe that God is the creator of the world and everything in it.
		Forgiveness	To stop blaming or being angry with someone for something they have done, or not punish them for something.
