

The children loved dressing up as Guy Fawkes and being in the hot seat as we discussed 'Why was Guy Fawkes angry?'.




Congratulations!



KS2 Christmas Concert will be Friday 15th December at 1.30pm (St Michael & All Angels Church).












Falmouth Primary Academy Choir


