What should I know already?

- ◆ Stories from the Bible show a Christian how to treat other people
- ◆ Christians believe that Jesus was the King (Messiah or Christ) and came to show God's love.
- ◆ Christians believe we should look after the world because it belongs to God.
- ◆ The story of The Good Samaritan teaches Christians that they should care for everyone, even people they don't like.

Skills

- Ask relevant questions.
- Reflect upon beliefs and practices..
- Explain concepts and practices.
- Draw conclusions which are balanced and related to evidence and experience.
- Make links between religion and human experiences, including our own experiences.

Essential Knowledge

- Christians believe Jesus challenges everyone about how to live – he sets the example for loving God and your neighbour; putting others first.
- Jesus shows love and forgiveness to unlikely people
- Christians try to be like Jesus – they want to know him better.
- Christians try to put Jesus' teaching and example into practice in lots of ways, from church worship to social justice.



Vocabulary

Christian	A person who believes in and follows the teachings of Jesus Christ.
Disciples	Someone who believes in and follows the teachings of Jesus Christ.
Fisher of people	Term given to Jesus' disciples when Jesus wanted them to share their faith and find more people to follow him.
God	Fundamental to Christian belief is the existence of God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Christians believe that God is all powerful, all knowing and eternal.
Gospel	Part of the Bible that contains the teachings of Jesus Christ and the story of his life.
Heal	To cure somebody or something from an illness or injury.
Jesus	The Son of God—his life and teachings form the basis of Christianity.
Leper	Somebody affected with leprosy (a tropical skin and nerve disease).
Outcasts	Somebody who has been rejected by a group or by society.
